




School Based Traineeships

for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Students





What is a School Based Traineeship?

An opportunity for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander school students in years 10 and 11 to complete an apprenticeship or traineeship while continuing in school, with the goal to continue to higher education or transition to work.

Example Case Study



Leila* is a 17 year old Indigenous Year 11 student studying a Business Administration Traineeship (Cert III).

By participating in our School Based Traineeship program, you'll have a student like Leila working for you while receiving the following benefits^:

Hourly Rate \$9.94 @ I day (7.5 hours per week) $= $74.55 \times 50 \text{ days} = $3,727.50$ (total cost over 12 months)

Payable to Employer at 6 months: \$2,250

Payable to Employer at 12 months upon successful completion of traineeship: \$2,500

Return to Employer: \$1,022.50
